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WordPower Publishing Kenya publishes Christian, non-fiction eBooks in English. We do not publish fiction, poetry, autobiographies, children's books or academic books.

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BOOK PRODUCTION 1

From the review stage, the manuscript will go into production. Book production has a number of processes to it. It includes copy editing, proofreading, formatting and eBook cover design.

Copy Editing

Copy editing is the process of checking for grammatical errors, inconsistencies in writing, repetition of words and phrases, syntax, punctuation, capitalization, hyphenation, facts, among others.

Copy editing is the final step before a manuscript is published. It is done after other edits like manuscript critique, comprehensive or line edit. At this stage, the author is not making any further changes. A copy edit polishes a manuscript and prepares it for publication.

The copy editor does not look at the overall view or structure of the manuscript. The editor simply corrects the mistakes in the text while preserving the voice of the author. A copy edit is done while the manuscript is in *MS Word*.

After copy editing, we proofread the manuscript before we send it to you for review and approval.

Proofreading

After copy editing a manuscript, proofreading is done as a quality control measure. The proofreader checks for mistakes that may have been missed during copy editing.

Proofreading points out misspellings, multiple words, too much space, misplaced words and sentences etc. and ensures that everything is rightfully placed. Proofreading also highlights any formatting errors.

BOOK PRODUCTION 2

Proof

Once we proofread the manuscript, we produce a Proof and send it to the author for review and approval. The Proof is a PDF version of the edited manuscript ready for publishing.
